**Saturday, Aug. 21, 2010**

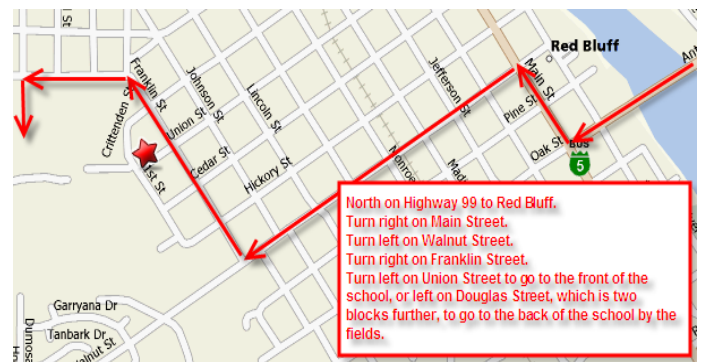

### DIRECTIONS TO RED BLUFF

- Turn right onto Franklin (before locksmith shop)
