Directions to Red bluff High school

*Merge onto CA-99 N via the ramp on the LEFT. 38.1 mi

*CA-99 N becomes ANTELOPE BLVD/HISTORIC US-99. 0.4 mi

*Turn RIGHT onto MAIN ST/I-5 BL/CA-36/HISTORIC US-99. 0.2 mi

*Turn LEFT onto WALNUT ST/CR-A7. 0.6 mi

*Turn RIGHT onto FRANKLIN ST. 0.2 mi

*Turn LEFT onto UNION ST. 0.1 mi

* 1260 UNION ST is on the RIGHT.

Parking at Red Bluff High School is very limited. The main parking lot is on Douglas Street. It is not a big lot by any means so carpooling is highly recommended. The parking lot on First Street is reserved for NorCal Fed and association badge holders only. You can park along the streets surrounding the High School but do not block residential driveways.

Red Bluff-Seating/shade – Neither the visitor side of the main field nor the practice fields have shade or bleachers. Make sure you bring chairs and ez-ups (shade tents).
