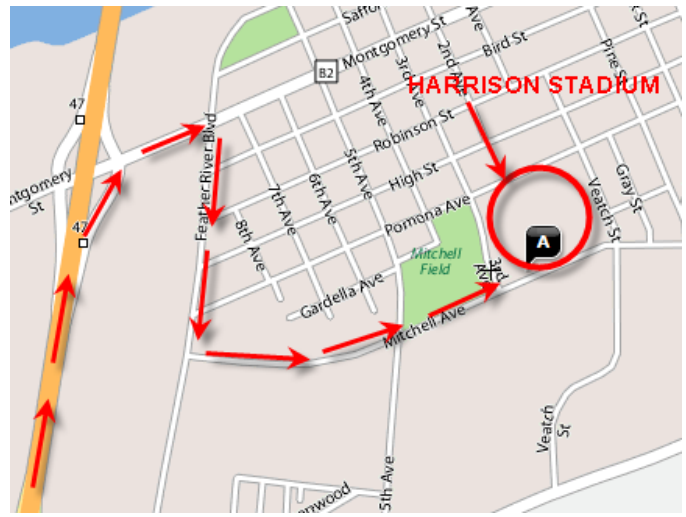
JAGUARS vs. OROVILLE RHINOS

- At stop, turn left onto Montgomery Street
- Turn right onto Feather River Blvd
- Turn left onto Mitchell Avenue
- Harrison Stadium will be on left-hand side
