Go Jags...Beat the Chiefs!!!



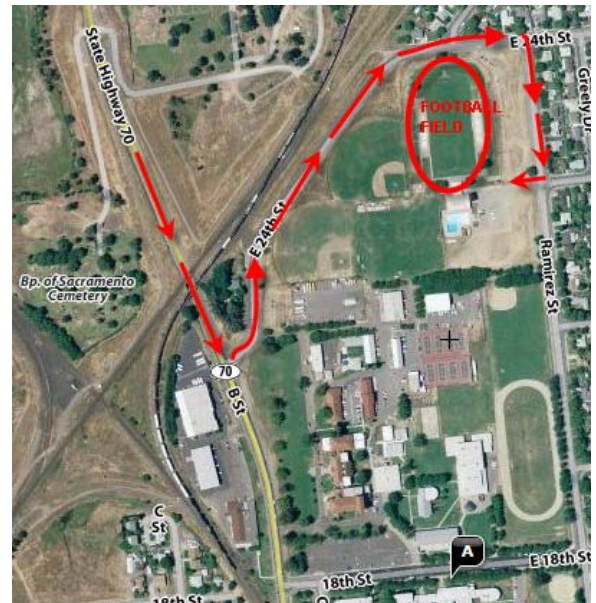
JAGUARS vs. MARYSVILLE
