PRACTICE

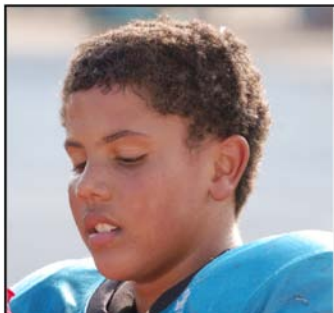
As always, if your son is going to miss practice for any reason, please have him give Coach Skip a call @ 321-3226. Leave a message if he's unable to answer.
